ICAR-IIOR organized a Farmers Training Course On Modern Approaches for Improving Oilseeds Productivity in Odisha

ICAR-IIOR organized a six-day training course for the farmers of Odisha sponsored by Crop Diversification Programme of Mega lift Irrigation Project, Government of Odisha during 02 to 07th December, 2024. Twenty five farmers and two officers participated in the training course.
